Yakult to Construct Second Indonesian Plant in East Java

Yakult Honsha Co., Ltd. (President: Takashige Negishi) today announced that its wholly owned subsidiary, P.T. Yakult Indonesia Persada, will construct in East Java its second plant for producing the Yakult fermented milk drink, which is expected to start production in December 2013.

P.T. Yakult Indonesia Persada launched sales of Yakult in 1991. Subsequently, the company continued and expanded its business, weathering the Asian economic crisis in 1997, and its sales have grown significantly, selling on average 2.25 million bottles of Yakult per day in 2011, up 27.5% from a year earlier. It currently produces Yakult at a plant near Jakarta, and has decided to construct the new plant as sales are expected to grow further with the future expansion in sales area.


